

## 8509-1 & 8609-1 Single Hole Lavatory Faucet Installation Instructions


**CALIFORNIA FAUCETS RECOMMENDS THAT ALL PLUMBING PRODUCTS BE INSTALLED BY A LICENSED PROFESSIONAL**

**IMPORTANT:** Read all instructions prior to installation and provide copy of instructions to consumer.

### Operating Specifications:

Recommended Supply Pressure: 20 to 70 psi\*

\* If water pressure exceeds 70 psi, install a Pressure-Reducing Valve (PRV).




### I INSTALLING FAUCET TO SINK/DECK

- Insert O-RING (2) into bottom of BASE (1a)
- Position COINED RING (1b) on top of BASE (1a), place RISER (1c) on top of COINED RING (1b), position SMOOTH RING (1d) on top of RISER (1c).
- Confirm orientation of RISER (1c); hash marks at bottom as shown
- Place parts over sink/deck THROUGH-HOLE (3)

**NOTE:** Recommended sink/deck THROUGH-HOLE is  $\varnothing 1-3/8"$


- Insert FLEX HOSE (5) (one at a time) and THREADED ROD (6) through BASE ASSEMBLY (1) and sink/deck THROUGH-HOLE (3)
- Place BODY (4) on top of BASE ASSEMBLY (1)
- From underside of sink/deck THROUGH-HOLE (3), place MOUNTING BRACKET (7) and NUT (8) onto THREADED ROD (6)
- Adjust positioning so MOUNTING BRACKET (7) contacts sink/deck on all sides
- Tighten NUT (8) until BODY (4) and BASE ASSEMBLY (1) are secure to sink/deck

### SPOUT ALIGNMENT

- Rotate SPOUT (10) to final position
- Raise decorative COVER (9) to expose SETSCREW (12)
- Tighten SETSCREW (12) with ALLEN KEY (11) until SPOUT (10) is secure
- Lower decorative COVER (9) to hide SETSCREW (12)

### SUPPLY CONNECTIONS

- Connect blue colored FLEX HOSE (5) to cold SUPPLY VALVE (13) and red colored FLEX HOSE (5) to hot SUPPLY VALVE (13)

**IMPORTANT:** Flush supply lines and valves prior to installation to prevent damage and malfunction of cartridge

- Turn on cold and hot SUPPLY VALVES (13)
- Slowly rotate faucet lever to allow water flow
- Check all connections for leaks and repair as necessary
- Give these instructions and Blue Plastic Aerator Key to consumer for safe keeping

**NOTE:** Occasionally, due to water conditions it may be necessary to remove aerator and clean debris off with soft bristle toothbrush
